
The CrystalView IP units (Transmitter to Receiver) can also be directly connected using standard network cabling terminated with RJ45 connectors.

The OSD allows you to access and change several functions and features. You can enable or disable the audio, enable or disable the IR feature, adjust the bandwidth and other features.

The IR feature of the CrystalView IP allows you to connect the IR transmitter to the CrystalView IP transmitter and aim it directly to a device's IP window. From the receiver side, you can use your remote control to send the information from the remote to the transmitter, and to the connected equipment like a DVD player or set top box.

Overview The CrystalView IP extender is usually sold in pairs, a transmitter unit and a receiver unit. The transmitter unit connects to your computers DVI-D video card connector, USB port, microphone and speaker ports. The receiver unit connects to DVI-D monitor, PS/2 keyboard and mouse, microphone and speakers. The transmitter and receiver unit are connected to your Ethernet network using standard network cabling.

Installation Installing the CrystalView IP extender is as simple as connecting the computer's monitor, USB, microphone, and speaker ports to the transmitter unit., connecting a DVI or VGA monitor, PS/2 keyboard and mouse, microphone and speakers to the receiver unit and connecting the local and remote units to your network. Configure each with an IP address and it's ready to use.
